If you are struggling with a certain skill or question, then either watch Mathswatch videos or ask your teacher to go through it with you.

Remember, it is not enough to revise/practice something once you must repeatedly return to topics so that you do not forget the skill.

Tip: It is also important to practice both non-calculator questions and calculator questions. You must be fluent at performing calculations without a calculator, but you must also understand fully how your calculator works.
