Dear parents and carers,

You may be aware from media coverage that the next dates for the NEU teaching union strike action for teaching staff will take place on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July and Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July. The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teachers' pay, and not because of any issues at our school.

We have updated our risk assessment for these days, and the arrangements that we can put in place to support our students in a safe and purposeful way, whilst mitigating the unknown circumstances on the day.

The school will be closed to the majority of students with the following exemptions for whom we will be able to deliver a set provision.

## Wednesday 5th July

- All students in year 9 will attend school to participate in the pre-planned University visit. This is a full school uniform trip and details have already been shared with you.
- Students in year 10 will attend school as normal.
- Students in years 7 and 8 should not attend school and will be provided with work to complete at home.

## Friday 7th July

- Students in year 10 will attend school as normal.
- Students who are involved in the inter-school athletics will attend school. You will be informed if this involves your child, and they should arrive in school at the normal time in their PE kit.
- Students in year 7, year 8 and year 9 should not attend school and will be provided with work to complete at home.

We will be able to provide packed lunches for students in receipt of free school meal funding. If you would like this, please inform us by the end of the day on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July.

Please note that on **Thursday 6th July** school is open as normal to all students and this is our sports day.
