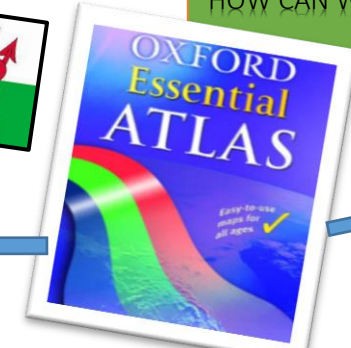




HOW CAN WE FIND OUT WHERE PLACES ARE?

- REPUBLIC OF IRELAND(EIRE)




THE UNITED KINGDOM IS MADE UP OF 4 DIFFERENT NATIONS,

HATE CRIME

The term 'hate crime' can be used to describe a range of criminal behaviour where the **perpetrator** is motivated by **hostility** or demonstrates hostility towards the victim's disability, race, religion, sexual orientation, gender or appearance.

Perpetrator = the person who carries out a crime.

HOSTILITY – bitterness, unkindness, malice
