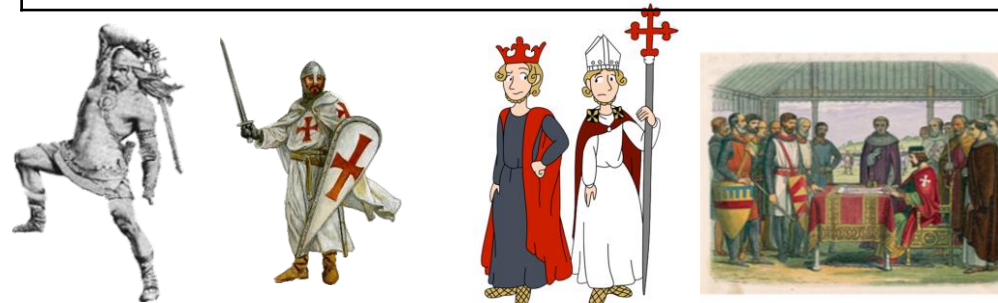

Feudal Pyramid of Power

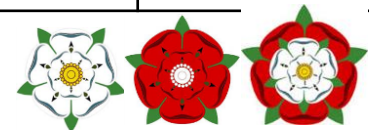
