


	Steel Rule		A steel rule is used to measure pieces of materials.
	Try Square		A try square enables a user to create a straight 90-degree line across a piece of material.
	Marking Gauge	×	A marking gauge generates a grove within a piece of timber which is parallel to the edge.
	Wooden Mallet		A wooden mallet is used to strike a chisel or an object.
	Chisel		A chisel is used to remove excess material.
	Tenon Saw	HEWIN J. PTS ACT MARKETINE	A tenon saw is used to cut through a piece of material vertically.
	Coping Saw		A coping saw is used to cut through a piece of material at any angle due to the small blade.
	Pillar Drill	7	The pillar drill is used to create holes within a piece of material.
	Bench Hook		A bench hook is used to hold a piece of material is place whilst it is being worked on.
