Uniform

Reminder to parents that the new rules for the school skirt come into effect when we return to school in September. A letter was sent out to Parents regarding uniform in June 2018 and a copy can be found on the school website. See below for the basic code of dress rules.

Blazer: School blazer **MUST** be worn. (Sleeves **MUST NOT** be rolled up).

Trousers: Plain black, tailored (No jeans, low-waisted trousers or leggings)

Tie: Black/red striped with integrated 'house' colour and school badge (only available from school)

Skirt: Plain black, pleated skirt **ONLY** (This is available from www.swi.co.uk)

Shirt: Plain white, long or short sleeved (not capped), which buttons to the neck (tucked in at all times)

School Sweatshirt: Plain black V neck with school embroidered logo

School Knitted Jumper Plain black V neck with school embroidered logo


