### **Advice Guide and Booking Procedure**

We are delighted to showcase what wonderful experiences we can provide your child this academic year. There are a number of curriculum based enrichment opportunities that support the relevant subject area that your child might be studying, along with a structured Enrichment Week in July 2023.

Please spend time with your child looking through the booklet, identifying the trips that would be suitable for them, and making sure the trip is available to your child's year group or option group, as some are for specific year groups or option groups. We have worked hard to ensure there are a number of trips and residentials covering a range of price brackets. We do not expect your child to go on every trip however we do recommend looking at the deposit and payment schedule and determining any financial impact it will have for your family, before registering your interest on a trip.

A web link to direct you to register your child's interest on any of the experiences available to your child is provided in the back of this booklet. Please make sure that your child definitely wants to participate and you can ensure all payment structures are adhered to prior to registering your interest on any of the experiences. We will not be running these on a first come first served basis, once we have received all of the names registered for each trip we will then undertake our selection process. Once this has been completed, on Friday 14th October 2022, we will confirm if your child has been given a place on the trip or if they have been put on the waiting list. Having received confirmation we will then open up ParentPay on Monday 17th October for you to settle deposits. The deadline for deposit payments will be Sunday 30th October 2022. At this stage if you have not paid your deposit we will then offer your place out to students on the waiting list to cover the allocated places for each trip.

#### **COVID Insurance Cover**

Please note that COVID requirements are individual to each trip and are subject to change. We can only give details based on current terms and conditions and if you agree to these and register interest on any residential (especially overseas), whilst we will endeavour to keep up to date with these, ultimately it will be your responsibility to ensure you are meeting the requirements and understand any financial risks associated with the visit.

#### Enrichment week July 2023

Each year group will have a particular curriculum focus for the week, we have also made every effort to offer trips and residentials at different price ranges to suit all. Year 7 and 8, alongside their curriculum focus, will have a residential available for them to register their interest for. This will be a great way of forging new relationships and working on their resilience by attempting some of the tasks and activities during each residential. Should you register your child's interest for any of the enrichment week residentials, please be aware that they would be away for the week so would be unable to attend the curriculum focused day trips such as Newstead Abbey or Yorkshire Wildlife Park.

Year 9 will all have a fun packed Extreme Sports activity day on site which will be run by Bolsover District Council, along with a day trip to Derbion Centre, where students will be able to apply their mathematical skills in a real-life setting. Year 10 will be undertaking their work experience Monday - Friday. The whole of KS3 will be involved in a sponsored event during Friday morning, more details to follow on this.

### Available to all Year 10 GCSE History Students

The History Department is running a trip for Year 10 History students to watch 'Inquisition of Elizabeth I', a play and workshop designed to help students improve their performance in GCSE History exams. The session includes: -

- A grade booster workshop.
- Explanation from examiners of the exam specifications and how to get more marks.
- A free 16-page workbook with answers for students to mark.
- The play is framed as a thought experiment in which students are asked to imagine that Queen Elizabeth has been captured by Catholic invaders and put on trial by a newly created English Inquisition. To save her own life, Elizabeth must provide a credible defence against their evidence.
- A free extension booklet that is specific to the OCR B exam.

This is an opportunity for students to consolidate and reinforce the knowledge on the GCSE topic 'The Elizabethans 1580-1603' which forms 20% of their GCSE.

# **GCSE Geography Fieldwork**



#### **Compulsory for all Year 10 GCSE Geography Students**

Students will engage in two separate field work studies: one human and one physical, undertaken on two separate days. The physical fieldwork will involve a river visit to the Burbage Brook in Derbyshire, meanwhile the human fieldwork will include a visit to Sheffield city centre to investigate shopping patterns and the impact of Meadowhall on city centre shopping habits.

Fieldwork is a compulsory element of the Geography GCSE course and the data and observations collected from both trips will contribute towards two exams (approx. 25% of the overall grade).

- We understand that behaviour and attendance will be monitored and will play a vital part in the decision as to whether a student can attend a chosen trip.
- We understand that the school has the final decision as to whether a student is able to attend a trip.
- We understand that any penalties imposed due to a cancellation or removal from a trip are liable for payment by the parent/carer.
- We understand that the cost for any property damaged while on a trip/activity due to carelessness, misconduct or deliberate intent will be the responsibility of the parent/carer.
- We understand that any behaviour not to a reasonable standard whilst on the trip, will result in arrangements being made for your child returning before the rest of the group. Parents/Carers will be responsible for collecting your child or any expenses incurred as a result of this.
- We understand that students are expected to have a great time whilst supporting and encouraging fellow students in a safe and responsible manner.
- We understand that all students are expected to uphold the excellent reputation of Tibshelf Community School.

### **Terms and Conditions**

#### PLEASE READ THESE CAREFULLY

#### **Behaviour**

You will have read and agreed to the Conduct Agreement when making your non-refundable deposit payment on ParentPay. By making the initial payment for any trip/activity, you and your child are automatically agreeing to abide by the terms and conditions of this agreement.

The school reserves the right to exclude from any trip/activity a student whose behaviour has given cause for concern at any stage during the year. Students removed from a trip/activity for behaviour or attendance issues will not be entitled to a refund.

If a student does not behave to a reasonable standard whilst on the trip, arrangements will be made him/her to return before the rest of the group. The parent/carer will be responsible for collecting their child or any expenses incurred as a result of this. The cost for any property damaged due to carelessness or misconduct of a student will be the responsibility of the parent/carer.

The school reserves the right to remove a student from any trip due to non-payment of deposits or instalments. You will **not** be entitled to a refund. If you wish to remove your child from a trip you must notify the school in writing. You will **not** be entitled to a refund. If you are having problems paying the instalment please notify the school in writing at the earliest opportunity.

#### Selection Process

Students will be randomly generated for each trip rather than on a first come first served basis. The remaining students will be placed onto a waiting list. Should someone drop out or fail to pay the deposit required, the same process for students on the waiting list will be repeated to take up that space.

#### <u>Insurance</u>

All trips are fully insured by the school's travel insurance. If your child is unable to take up their place due to a medical condition, we require confirmation from a Doctor. Please contact the Finance Department at school before you obtain this information. Items such as mobile phones are taken at the owner's risk.

#### **COVID Insurance Cover**

Please note that COVID requirements are individual to each trip and are subject to change. We can only give details based on current terms and conditions and if you agree to these and register interest on any residential (especially overseas), whilst we will endeavour to keep up to date with these, ultimately it will be your responsibility to ensure you are meeting the requirements and understand any financial risks associated with the visit.

#### Cancellation and Refund Policy—ALL PAYMENTS ARE NON REFUNDABLE

Cancellation must be received by the school in writing. *Please note that refunds are only given where a legitimate claim can be made against our School Travel Insurance.* All claims are subject to the terms of our cover.
