As part of the raising aspirations programme, I am delighted to offer your child a visit to the most prestigious university in the world, Oxford University. The aim of the visit is to provide students with an insight into university life to help them make informed choices about their future. Oxford University is ranked number 1 in the university league tables for the UK.

Students will take part in a range of activities delivered by university staff, graduates, and student ambassadors. They will also be taken on a tour of the university and will have opportunities to ask questions regarding all aspects of higher education.
