The government has introduced new relationships, sex and health education (RSHE) guidance, that we're required to follow from **1st September 2026**.

Because of this, we've been consulting with parents/carers, pupils and staff to make sure our new curriculum meets the government's requirements, as well as the needs of all our pupils.

We've worked hard to make sure that our new curriculum reflects:

- Our pupils' ages and developmental stages, as well as their physical and emotional maturity and cultural and religious backgrounds
- Every pupil's learning needs, including the needs of any pupils with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND)
- Our school's vision and values
- What pupils need to know to be healthy and safe in school, in their personal relationships and in the wider world

We are currently in the process of updating our RSHE policy to ensure it is in line with the new statutory changes.
