Tutor session

To help your child acclimate to our school, we have organised a Tutor drop-in session before the Transition week begins. This session will be available on **Thursday 13th June from 3.30pm – 5.00pm in the Main Hall**, you do not need to make an appointment, but it will allow you and your child to meet their new form tutor should they have any anxieties prior to the transition week. If you had any questions that have not been answered via our student and parent booklets, or you feel it necessary to speak with our pastoral team prior to transition week, then please come along to this event. If you've gathered all the necessary information that you need then we will look forward to seeing your child on the first day of transition week.

Transition Week

Students will attend transition week this year on **Monday 24th June – Thursday 27th June**, students should report to the front of the school building at 8.15am where staff will help guide them onto the tennis courts to be registered. Can I take this opportunity to remind parents that the car park is a one-way system in the morning and is simply used to drop students off, no parking spaces are allocated to parents as these will be used by our staff. After school parents must collect students at 2.50pm **outside of the school grounds**, this includes via car. The main car park has a barrier system in operation; therefore, you will not be allowed to use the car park to collect students via car or to use it as a turning circle.

During this week, your child will have the opportunity to meet other members of their form, their form tutor, head of year and SLT link. On the first day your child will have a welcome meeting in the main hall, followed by time with their form, before experiencing a broad range of subjects and activities to welcome them to life at Tibshelf Community School. Students should wear their primary school uniform during the week and bring their PE kit with them. Other items such as a pencil case, hat, water bottle and sun cream are recommended.

Summer School

There will be a Summer School being delivered this year, and it will follow a similar pattern to previous years. Further details about how to sign up and what the programme will look like will be shared with you shortly after half term.

Communication

Communication and partnership with parents are essential to ensure your child's success. We value your involvement in your child's education and encourage you to stay connected with us through regular parent – teacher meetings, school events and our online platforms. We believe that by working together, we can create a supportive and enriching educational experience for your child. Over the next couple of days, you should have received two separate communications, one with details about how to register your Parent Pay account and another informing you how to sign up to our Arbor App. **Included in the communication should be what your child's tutor details are, this information will be required if you intend to come along to the tutor drop-in sessions and will be required for the first day of transition.**

Medical and dietary needs

By completing the school admission forms online you will have alerted us to your child's medical and dietary needs if you haven't yet completed the admission forms please do so as a matter of urgency.
